

BUMBUGUR DISTRICT

- ∞ Area: 3044 square km land
- ∞ Geography: Semi arid continental climate.
 District located between the Khangai mountain range (2000 to 2750m) and the Gobi desert (1500-2000m altitude).
 In the North, temperatures are lower and water resources are more abundant.
 Geological fault crosses from west to east.
 The high-altitude plateau areas, low-sloping mountain areas and the main valleys will be valued for their high fodder yields and the existence of water resources. To a lesser extent the courses in the piedmont area and the flattest endorheic basin are also valued for their water resources.
